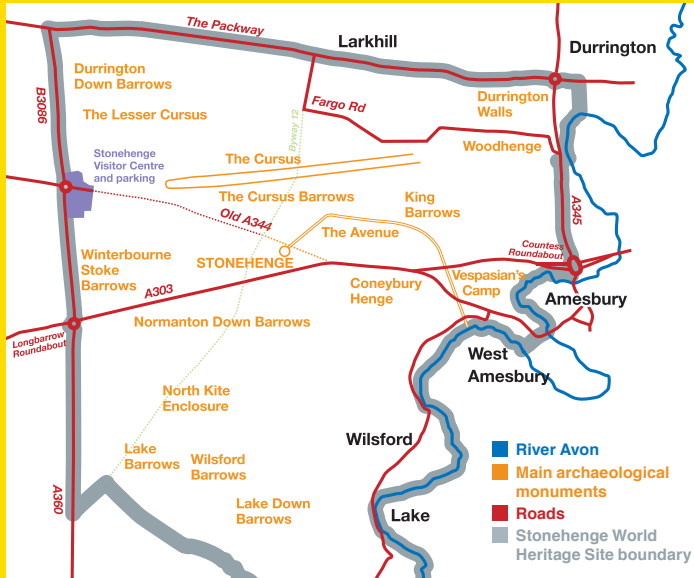

Stonehenge World Heritage Site **UNDER THREAT**



The UK Government plans to widen the A303 road with a 2.9km tunnel across the iconic Stonehenge World Heritage Site (WHS) which is over 5.4km wide.

The new dual carriageway, tunnel portals and two grade-separated junctions would cause irreparable damage to the WHS in breach of the UNESCO World Heritage Convention.

Any new road engineering must not cause further damage to this greatly revered archaeological landscape.
