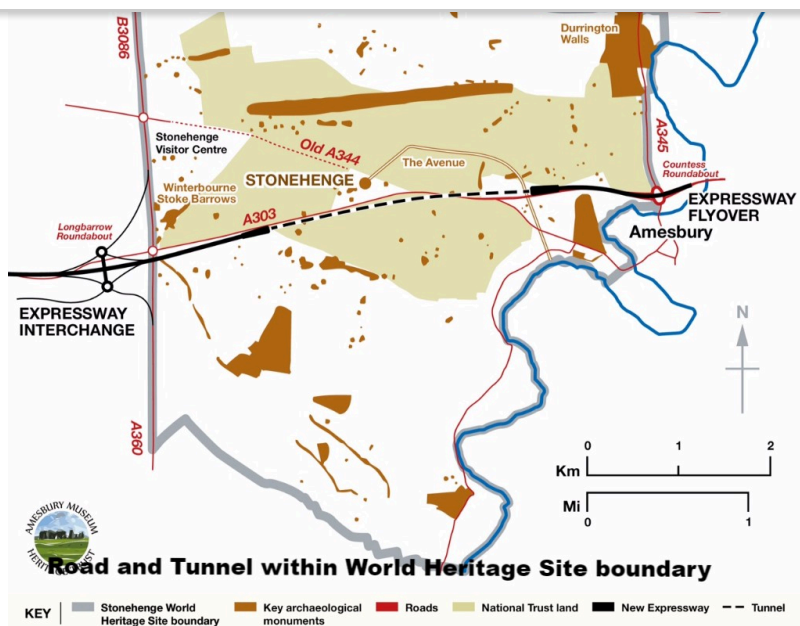
Dear <<First Name>>

Thank you so much for supporting our fight to protect the Stonehenge prehistoric landscape from severe damage by a major road scheme. As World Heritage Day approaches I am writing to ask you to share our appeal **before the consultation closes on 23 April**. Here is our appeal:

- The Stonehenge World Heritage Site (WHS) is a unique landscape famous for its large henges with stone settings and other monuments, burial mounds and settlement remains described by UNESCO as “**a landscape without parallel**”.
- Right now the UK Government is pressing ahead with plans to build a **four-lane ‘expressway’ and tunnel that will go right across the World Heritage Site**.



- The plan is to build an entirely new dual carriageway, construct vast interchanges that will devastate this remarkable place forever. These plans are in breach of the UNESCO World Heritage Convention.



- UNESCO's [World Heritage Committee](#) recommended that the UK Government should consider alternatives. But Highways England plans have disregarded this.
- **This scheme is nothing short of an international scandal and sets a dangerous precedent.**
- If we allow the A303 Stonehenge scheme to go ahead, we believe that **other World Heritage Sites will not be safe from the bulldozer.**
- That is not all. Precious nature areas and rare birds, important chalk streams and warm springs could be at risk as well. Nevertheless the full environmental impact information is missing from this consultation.
