There are only **5 days left** to register to object to the A303 Stonehenge Expressway. We urge everyone concerned about the impact of the dual carriageway and tunnel construction to register their objection with the Planning Inspectorate. The form is very simple.

The Planning Inspectorate wishes to examine those aspects of key importance to objectors as part of the examination process. Following the Examination, the Examining Authority (panel of inspectors) will recommend to the Secretary of State for Transport whether or not the road scheme should be approved. **Registration closes on Friday 11 January 2019 at 23:59**
