Last week we learned from Save Stonehenge World Heritage Site Ltd (SSWHS) that the legal challenge by SSWHS to Transport Secretary Grant Shapps' outrageous decision to go ahead with the A303 Stonehenge scheme will be heard in the High Court from **Wednesday**, **23 to Friday**, **25 June**. This means that the legal challenge will take not one but three days in court. The grounds for contesting the decision by SSWHS can be found here.

Thanks to your generosity the initial target of £50,000 for the challenge was reached extraordinarily rapidly. This enabled the legal team to go forward with the preparatory work necessary for the judicial review and successfully negotiate the first hurdle.

> It is no surprise, however, that a complex, landmark case such as this is going to be more expensive than at first anticipated. The legal team is already working at a heavily discounted rate but the three-day hearing requires considerable extra work, so SSWHS has been asked to raise the CrowdJustice target to £80,000.

This is a lot to ask but to prepare for the next hurdle we urge our campaign supporters to help SSWHS to continue to fight this appalling scheme.
