

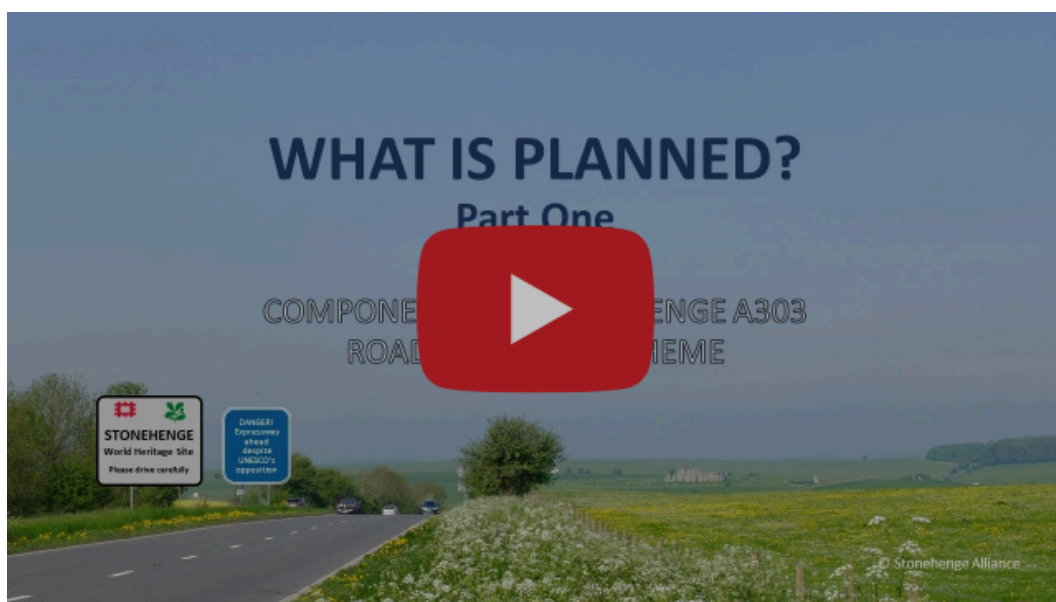
VIDEO: WHAT IS PLANNED FOR THE STONEHENGE WORLD HERITAGE SITE?
