Dear Supporter,

Last November brought a welcome critique by the National Audit Office of the government's road projects. Prices for construction had spiraled at record rates, and the NAO recommended a value for money review of projects with a weak business case, including the Stonehenge scheme.

This prompted our team to shine a light on the scheme's figures published in their report Stonehenge Road Scheme Doesn't Add Up!

The Stonehenge Alliance had long considered the figures to justify the scheme lacked crediblity and should not be used as a basis to validate the scheme. Now, however, National Highways' new calculations can only be described as pure fantasy. Remarkably, National Highways claims that the £2.5bn project has suddenly become much better value for money, **costs have reduced and benefits increased.**

Any figures National Highways produces will need to be carefully scrutinised. We are calling for an open and independent appraisal of the scheme to be carried out **before** any decision is made by the Transport Secretary, Mark Harper. Stonehenge WHS is at stake and we owe it to future generations to take the greatest possible care of it.


