Tom Holland interviews Mike Parker Pearson

Numerous archaeologists, including many in ICOMOS, the body that advises UNESCO, are against the A303 road proposals. One of them is Professor Mike Parker Pearson. We are delighted that he agreed to give us his views about the road proposal as part of our fund raiser.

Professor Parker Pearson is one of the world's leading authorities on Stonehenge, and is Professor of British Later Prehistory at the Institute of Archaeology, University College London. Below is a preview of the first of three short videos where Professor Parker Pearson starts off by describing the Stone Circle's unique features and possible functions. This video will be published on social media from tomorrow.
