**'What's so special about the Stonehenge landscape?'**

In the second of three videos Professor Mike Parker Pearson answers Tom Holland's questions about the importance of the Stonehenge landscape, especially at the western end where the proposed road scheme would damage unique archaeology in the ground, where there is evidence of a huge settlement and farmsteads built in the Middle Bronze Age, around 1500 BC.
