**'What's wrong with the Stonehenge road scheme?'**

In this interview we find out why Professor Mike Parker Pearson is not in favour of the road scheme. Tom Holland pushes hard about mitigation, thus we learn about the technical limitations, the potential loss, the problem of the sheer scale of the scheme and the need for the whole site to be protected in perpetuity for future generations.

Professor Parker Pearson's arguments are shared by many Stonehenge specialists. He led a group of 22 senior scholars who, together with other expert organisations such as the Wiltshire Archaeological and Natural History Society and the Council for British Archaeology, gave persuasive evidence at the Examination against the scheme that the Independent Examiners upheld, but which, as we know, was overturned.

Hence the need for this appeal to support the legal challenge starting next Monday.
